INFORMATION AND CONDITIONS

- 1. Competitors will be made Honorary Members of the Clubs throughout the meeting.
- 2. Races will be sailed under Sailing World Rules with the special provisions required by the R.Y.A., except where indicated in the Sailing Instructions.
- 3. A current Certificate of Insurance must be held with minimum Third Party Cover of £2,000000
- 4. Helmsmen and Crews must be Amateur Members of a recognised Club.
- 5. Class races will be held only for a minimum of five boats entered for the entire week. Entries below this number will take part in the Handicap Races. A fifth race start may be added if additional fleets reach the minimum requirement.
- 6. An additional prize for the week will be awarded to the most successful Overall Helm, the most successful UI8 helm and to the most successful Lady Helm.
- 7. Races for All comers will be restricted to Monohulls with a PY of less than 1210 in at least two fleets, determined by entries.
- 8. All boats must sail under their proper registered sail numbers throughout the week. There will be no deviation from this rule without the prior permission of the Race Officer.
- 9. All competitors will be required to sign on and off for all races refer to sailing instructions for penalties.
- 10. The trophies are to be held for one year.
- 11. Points will be awarded on results throughout the Week.
 - If 9 or more races are sailed 3 races may be discarded.
 - If 8 races are sailed 2 races may be discarded.
 - If 6 or 7 races are sailed 1 race may be discarded.
 - If 5 or fewer races are sailed there will be no discards.

Boats wishing to qualify for weekly points must have entered ALL races of the series two hours before the first race. Points will only be awarded to boats entered for the whole series. Boats entered for the whole series, and unable to race on any day will be awarded points equal to the total number of entries for the whole series.

- 12. Entrants who, owing to unforeseen circumstances, cannot compete in the series may apply for refund of the entry fee.
- 13. Caravan parking spaces are usually available near the clubs. Advice should be obtained from individual secretaries. Free camping is available at Snettisham Beach and at the OASC.
- 14. Parking fees may be charged at Blakeney. We ask the co-operation of competitors in paying these charges which have been imposed by the The National Trust, not the Sailing Club.
- 15. Owing to shortage of space at Hunstanton, only 65 boats will be allowed to enter, entries should be received by July 1st and no entries will be accepted on the day if this number is reached.
