1 Events

Wells Bowl for National 12s

2 Courses

Will be laid in the harbour in the area of the Lifeboat House. The start will be between the committee boat mast and an adjacent mark giving if possible a windward start. Marks to be taken are listed overleaf, set on red or green background with a number indicating no. of rounds.

Time Limit- of 2 hrs will be used at the discretion of the race officer to facilitate the safe return of boats.

3 Lead Boat – if possible will guide competitors round the first lap.

We will attempt to inform boats who are OCS as soon as possible.

4 Retirements – Competitors are reminded that retirements should be entered on the club notice board. Please inform the race officer or support boat, if possible, before leaving race area.

5 Commercial users – at times the water may be congested especially near to the entrance of the new harbour. Be aware that larger windfarm/fishing boats have little room for manoeuvre, therefore having right of way. Plan ahead.

6 General information

Parking – for boats and trailers ; land to the west of clubhouse and on club boat park . **Parking – for cars ;** Old railway cutting to SE of club and Harbour compound east of clubhouse.

All parking will be signed. Please park economically and do not block commercial properties. **Launching –** Do not rig on the slipway. Launching can be from club slipway or public slipway to the west. Please do not leave trolleys on public highway. **Towing –** if the wind is light or from the west towing is likely to be needed. Carry a tow rope of suitable length. (4 – 5 metres) We will assist on return if necessary.

7 Bar and refreshments

The clubhouse will be open before & after sailing.

8 Prizegiving

In the clubhouse as soon as possible after racing.
