INFORMATION AND CONDITIONS 2025

- 1. Competitors will be made Honorary Members of the Clubs throughout the meeting.
- 2. Races will be sailed under World Sailing Rules with the special provisions required by the R.Y.A., except where indicated in the Sailing Instructions.
- 3. A current Certificate of Insurance must be held with minimum Third Party Cover of £5,000,000
- 4. Helmsmen and Crews must be Amateur Members of a recognised Club.
- 5. Class races will be held only for a minimum of five boats entered for the entire week. Entries below this number will take part in the Handicap Race(s). A fifth race start may be added if additional fleets reach the minimum requirement.
- 6. Additional prizes for the week will be awarded to the most successful Overall Helm, the most successful UI8 helm and to the most successful Lady Helm.
- 7. Races for Allcomers will be restricted to Monohulls with a PY of less than 1220 in fleets determined by entries.
- 8. Competitors may only use sails displaying numbers other than those under which they are entered if agreed by the Race Officer at least 1 hour before the start of racing on that day.
- 9. All competitors will be required to sign on and off for all races refer to sailing instructions for penalties.
- 10. The trophies are to be held for one year and trophy holders must then ensure they are returned.
- 11. Points will be awarded on race results throughout the Week.
 - If 11, 12 or 13 races are sailed 3 races may be discarded.
 - If 8, 9 or 10 or more races are sailed 2 races may be discarded.
 - If 6 or 7 races are sailed 1 race may be discarded.
 - If 5 or fewer races are sailed there will be no discards.

Boats wishing to qualify for weekly points must have entered the series two hours before the first race. Points will be awarded to all entered boats taking part in the racing. Boats entered for the whole series, and unable to race on any day will be awarded points equal to the total number of weekly entries for the whole series in their fleet.

- 12. Payment may be made by cash, cheque, bank transfer and card reader.
- 13. Entrants who, owing to unforeseen circumstances, cannot compete in the series may apply for refund of the entry fee.
- 14. Caravan parking spaces are usually available near the clubs. Advice should be obtained from individual secretaries. Free camping is available at Snettisham Beach and at the OASC, and cheap camping is available in Nina's field (see website) for £5/night.
- 15. Parking fees will be charged at Blakeney except for National Trust members. We ask the cooperation of competitors in paying these charges which have been imposed by the National Trust, not the Sailing Club.
- 16. Entry forms and fees should be sent to Mr David Baddeley 29 Kirk Road, Walpole St Andrew, Wisbech, Cambridgeshire PE14 7LL. You should pay the £5 harbour fee (Code OS5) if you are sailing at Overy Staithe on Wednesday 13th August. See entry form for conditions for reduced rates. Please collect your boat sticker at reception on the first day you sail.
